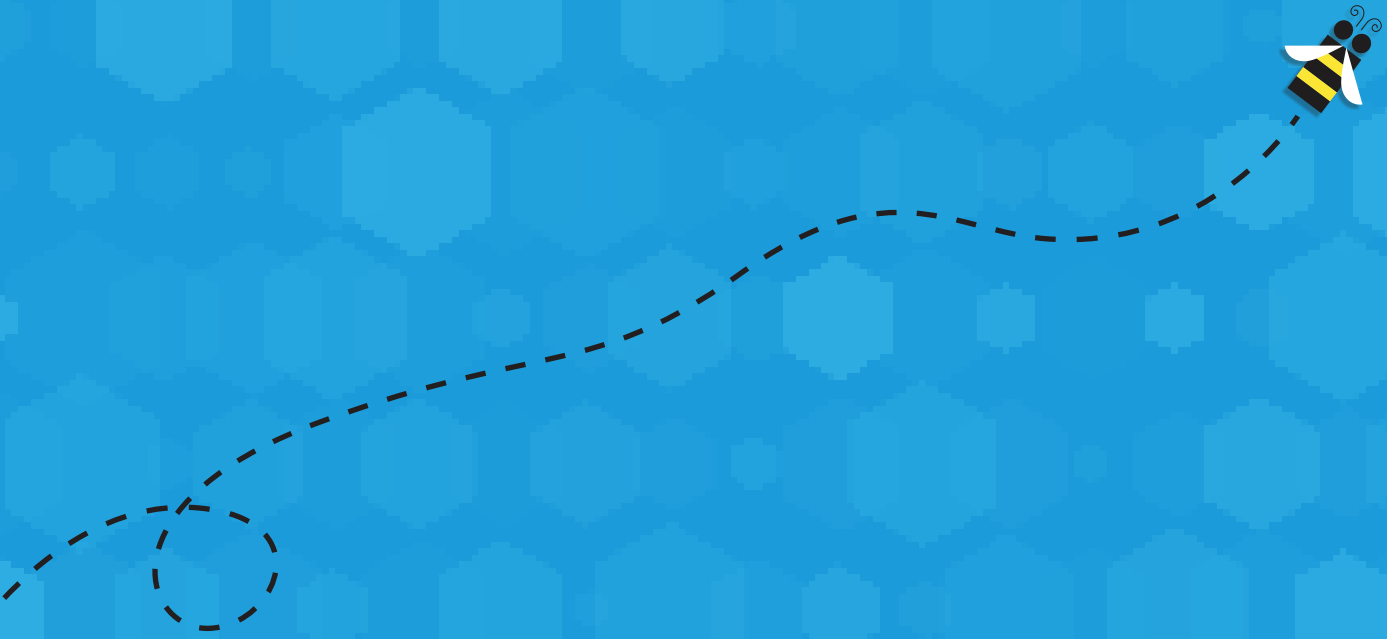

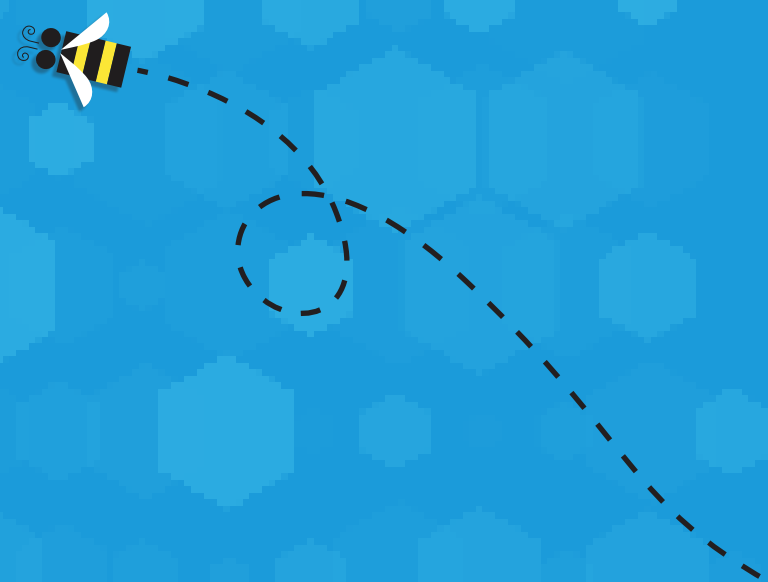
A Big Time Spellebrity
